



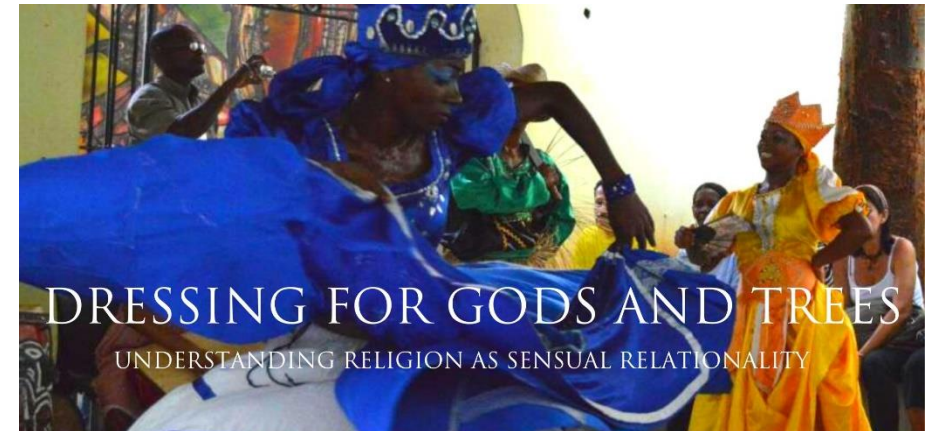

<p>“Dressing for gods and trees: understanding religion as sensual relationality”</p> <p><i>Abstract:</i></p> <p>What we wear tells others something about our perception of ourselves and, sometimes at least, our perception of others. Most if not all cultures explicitly or implicitly familiarize people with the more-or-less formal or informal dress-codes appropriate to specific occasions and relationships. I am intrigued by the ways in which people prepare to meet important other-than-human kin (e.g. deities, ancestors, venerable trees, sacred rivers). Attention to these preparations promises to contribute significantly to growing scholarly dialogue about the (braided-together) sensuality, materiality and relationality of religion. In this presentation, I introduce current research about some ways in which Indigenous people and animists engage with the larger-than-human world. Focusing on the weaving together of bodily senses and the worldly sensorium improves scholarly engagement with ceremonial interactions between different species. The mutual coming-into-being of humans and other-than-human kin shape ways of belonging to and interacting with places and communities. Some thoughts about how these Indigenous and animist ways of world-making should also cast light on seemingly better known religious and cultural phenomena.</p>
